To Our Patients:

Dentists, like all providers of healthcare services, are now required by federal law to inform their patients of their policies regarding privacy of patient information. Types of Nonpublic Personal Information We Collect

We collect nonpublic personal information about you that is provided to us by you or obtained with your authorization.

Parties to Whom We Disclose Information

For current and former patients, we do not disclose any nonpublic personal information obtained in the course of our practice except as required or permitted by law. Permitted disclosures include, for instance, providing information to employees and, in limited situations, unrelated third parties who need to know that information to assist me in providing services to you. An example of these would be your referring doctor responsible for related aspects of your care and insurance carriers who assist in your financial responsibilities for treatment(s) received.

Protecting the Confidentiality and Security of Current and Former Patients' Information

We retain records relating to professional services provided so that we are better able to assist you with your professional needs and, in some cases, to comply with professional and legal guidelines. In order to guard your non-public personal information, we maintain physical, electronic, and procedural safeguards that comply with our professional standards.
